TITLE AND AUTHOR (2 PTS)



ABSTRACT (8 PTS)

- No italicized directions should appear in your submission.
- Find your information on <u>this linked page</u> concerning background information with references provided in APA.
- State your hypothesis and provide background on your topic in your own words on this slide.



MATERIALS AND METHODS (7 PTS)

- Explain the methods of the CDC PLACES data set you are using.
- Find your topic on <u>this linked page</u> to see information about the numerator and denominator for your topic percentages.
- Include information about the significance and limits of the data in your own words.
 - Significance and limits of the data are also visible in the provided linked page.



DATA TABLE (10 PTS)

- This slide should only include a data table regarding your hypothesis.
- Generate a data table easily using the tool provided in the OneDrive version of PowerPoint.
 - This tool uses data in the format you generated in LAB 9.
- The data table content should be labeled and accurate.



GRAPH (10 PTS)

- This slide should only include a graph regarding your question.
- Generate a graph easily using the tool provided in the OneDrive version of PowerPoint.

- Refer to LAB 9 for an example.

• The graph should contain a title, axis labels and accurate data.



DISCUSSION (7 PTS)

- This slide will contain an explanation of the data table and graph in paragraph of 3-5 sentences using appropriate scientific vocabulary and grammar. This is also where you indicate whether the results support or do not support your hypothesis.
 - You do not lose points if the hypothesis is not supported.



OPTIONAL (0 PTS)

- Additional slides are optional and provide an opportunity to expand information provided about the topic.
- No points are awarded for additional slides.
- Template provides a minimum of slides, not a maximum.
- Creativity should be part of the process. Use colors and graphics of your own choice.



REFERENCES (6 PTS)

- This slide should contain a minimum of three references in APA format regarding your topic.
- Your topic on <u>this linked page</u> contains appropriate APA references listed numerically.
